Illinois Energy Now (IEN) is a suite of energy efficiency programs administered by the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity. Each year more than \$70 million is available to make large scale equipment improvements to the electric and natural gas systems. Find out more at www.ilenergynow.org.

The Metropolitan Mayors Caucus Public Sector Energy Efficiency Program administers Illinois Energy Now funding to public agencies in Northeastern Illinois to update and retrofit facilities to improve energy efficiency and save money. Free technical assistance and project support is provided by 360 Energy Group.

Grant reimbursements can be up to \$300,000 per facility location for projects including boiler and chiller replacements, HVAC system tune-ups, indoor and outdoor lighting upgrades, heat distribution system upgrades, pipe insulation, and more. Learn more and apply online at www.mayorscaucus.org.

Program Process for Public Agencies:

1. Identify energy efficiency project(s)
2. Submit a [Project Proposal Form](#)
3. Receive free technical assistance to complete assessments, tech reports, and bid specs (as needed)
4. Receive an award letter from the Caucus, estimating grant reimbursement amount (based on predicted energy savings)
5. Complete projects by May 8, 2017
6. Receive grant reimbursement payment

432 Public Sector Energy Efficiency Projects within **97 communities** have been completed since 2011, administered by the Metropolitan Mayors Caucus.

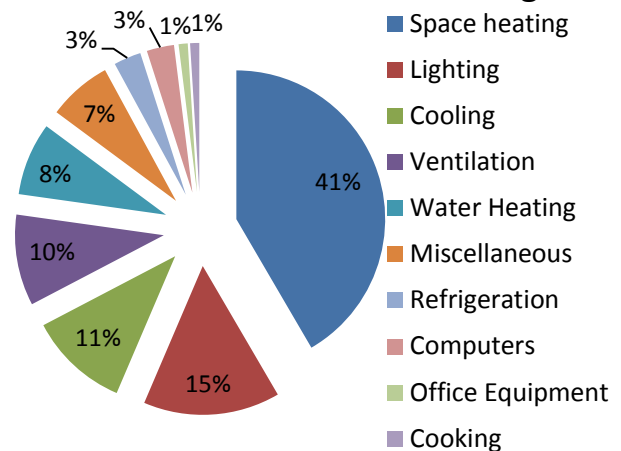
