

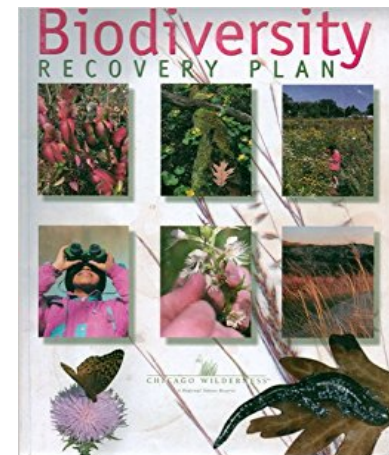


## Environmental Planning in Schaumburg:

- 2001: VOS supports Chicago Wilderness Biodiversity Recovery Plan
- 2004: VOS Biodiversity Recovery Plan  
Biodiversity Regulations
- 2005: USCM Climate Protection Agreement
- 2007: VOS supports Greenest Region Compact 1; October, 2007
- 2008: Staff directed to complete an inventory of green initiatives
- 2009: Village Board approved C GAP (Comprehensive Green Action Plan)
- 2010: EECBG (Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant) Program
- 2014/5: CMAP Local Technical Assistance Program applications
- 2016: VOS adopts Resolution of Support for GRC2; April 26, 2016
- 2018: Update to C GAP
