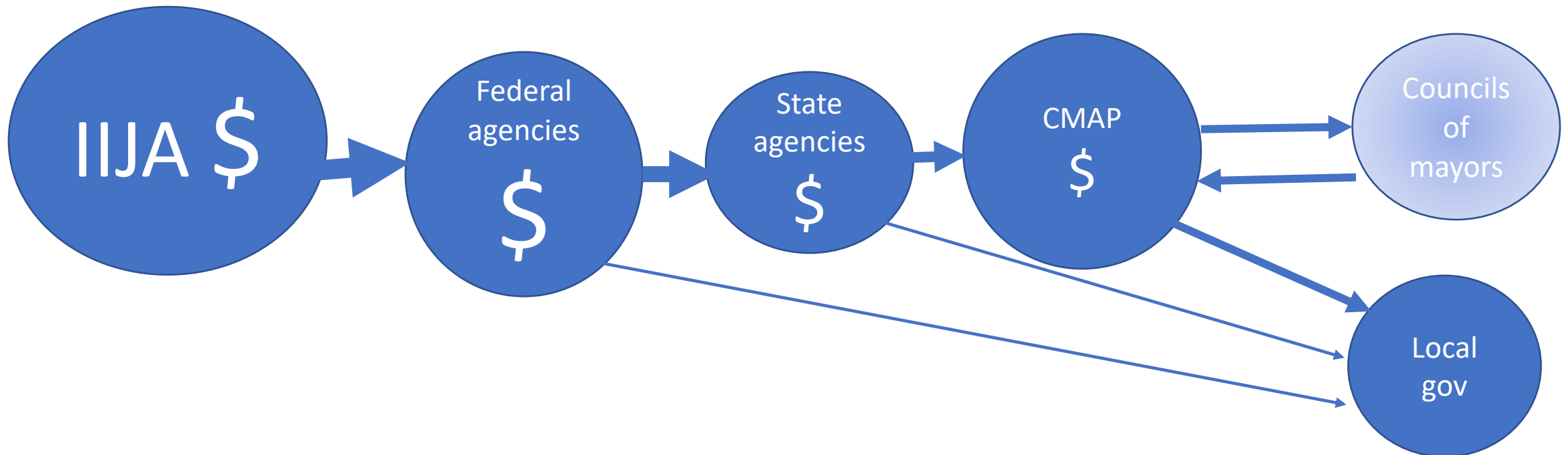

IIJA

- Add funds to existing transportation programs (STP, TAP, CMAQ)
- May create new grant programs to target local government
- Overlay new rules on existing framework

IDOT letter of January 13:

Announces (FY) 2023 federal **Surface Transportation Program** (STP), Local Bridge Formula Program, and State Matching Assistance Program allotments.

*“There is approximately a **27% increase** in the federal formula **program allotments as a result of the passage of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA).**”*

NEW RULES ARE

USDOT issued Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) Jan 14
**Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity
(RAISE).**

*“..this NOFO does not contain full requirements...USDOT intends to

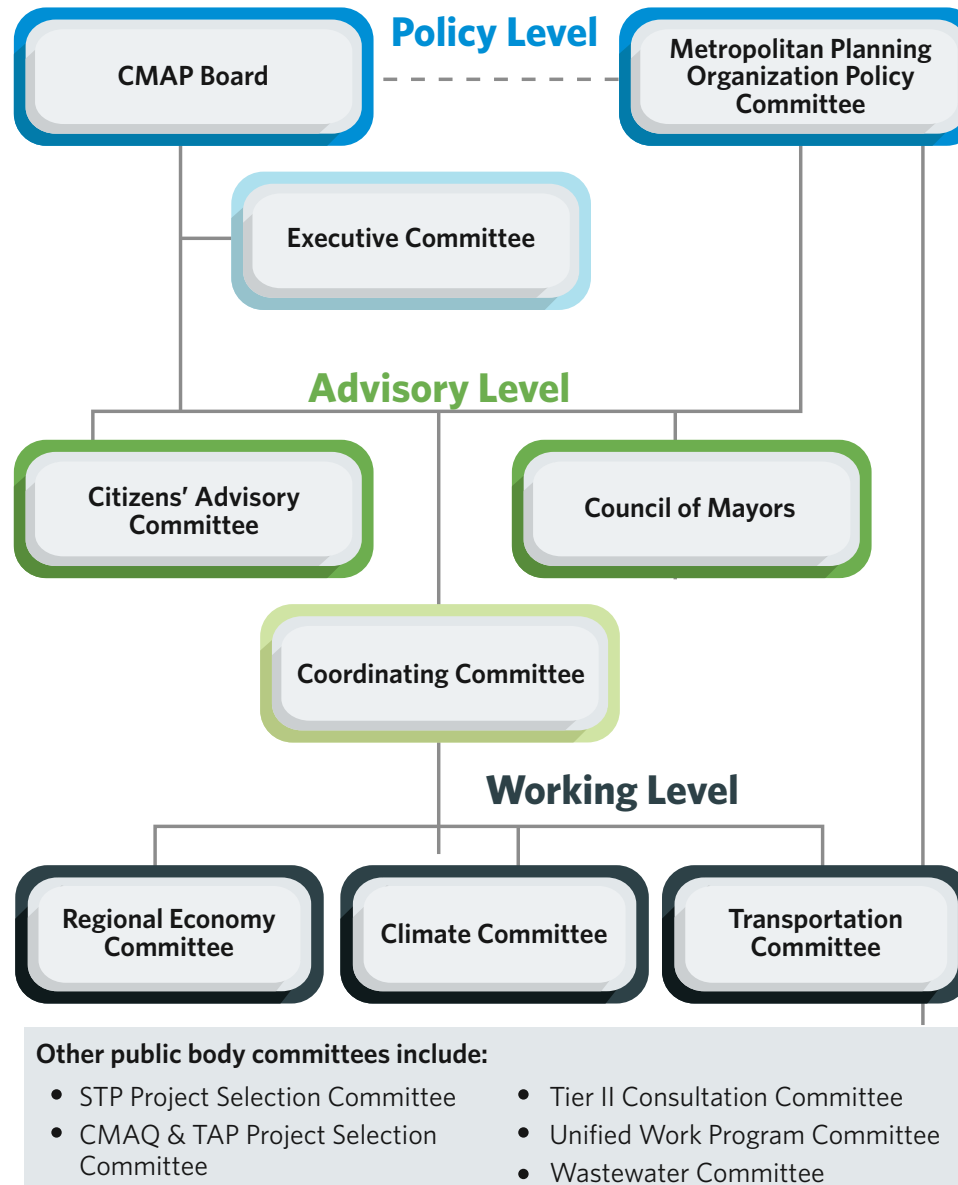
