Most municipalities have participated in utility-sponsored energy efficiency programs that provide rebates and incentives for energy efficiency products and services. Utility programs have helped public agencies assess and upgrade their own facilities and provide energy savings services to residents and businesses.

These utility programs stem from state statute, the <u>Climate and Equitable Jobs Acts (CEJA)</u> (<u>subsection f</u>), and earlier legislation that established the <u>Energy Efficiency Resource Standards</u>. Every four years, gas and electric utilities are required to prepare plans for meeting energy efficiency targets and to show that they can document cost-effective and equitable energy savings.

ComEd, Nicor Gas, North Shore Gas and Peoples Gas have completed their plans and have submitted them to the Illinois Commerce Commission for approval, with revisions required by CEJA.

Join us for the June Environment Committee meeting to learn about their Energy Efficiency Plans including the plan development process, program targets, tracking metrics, and funding mechanisms. Representatives from ComEd, Nicor Gas, North Shore Gas and Peoples Gas will share their plans for the residential, targeted income-eligible, commercial and industrial, and public sector energy efficiency programs that will help us reach our climate goals while benefitting utility customers.
