

GRANT OVERVIEW

Grants will be awarded to community-based nonprofits and other eligible organizations in three concurrent grant tiers:

- **Tier One** (1-year grants): Up to \$150,000 for <u>assessment</u>
- Tier Two (2-year grants): Up to \$250,000 for planning
- Tier Three (2-year grants): Up to \$350,000 for project development or pilot projects
- Up to \$75,000 (noncompetitive 1-year grants): for capacity building for capacity-constrained communities

ISSUE AREAS

Grants will support projects that focus on issues including, but not limited to:

- o Environmental health
- Air, soil, and water quality
- Healthy homes
- o Access to healthy food
- o Stormwater and green infrastructure
- Emergency preparedness and disaster resiliency
- o Environmental job training



HOW YOU CAN PREPARE

- Apply for a unique Entity ID (UEI) through sam.gov
- Prepare accounting and record-keeping systems
- Plan time to develop program plan and budget
- Submit application prior to Fall 2026
