Most of us throw away broken household items and replace them with new items. What about fixing broken things? Keeping valuable items in service reduces waste, saves money and avoids the environmental impacts of producing and distributing new consumer goods.

In 2009 in Amsterdam, the idea of the Repair Café was born. Now there are more than 3,500 community Repair Cafes around the world. Their purpose is to help people repair serviceable clothing, small appliances, lamps, electronics, jewelry, cutlery, and more while building a community culture of service and repair. Volunteer repair coaches share their skills and demonstrate to patrons how repairs are done. Repair Café International also shares an immense do-it-yourself repair library to build skills.

<u>Oak Park</u> started the first Repair Café in our region in 2013 and boasts a repair rate of 68%. There are now also repair cafes in Lyons Township, Romeoville, Evanston, and Chicago. This meeting will bring together hosts and organizers of these community repair events.
