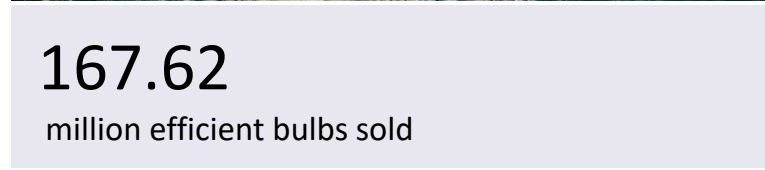

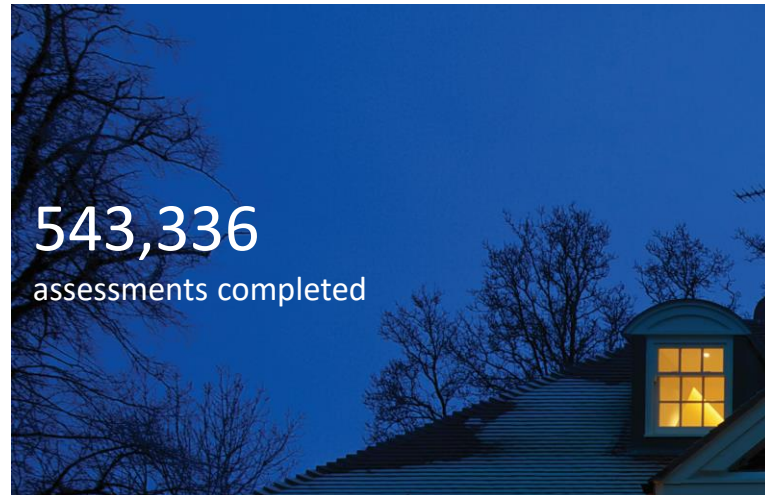

MULTI-FAMILY ENERGY SAVINGS

Income Eligible & Public Housing Authorities

Property owners and managers for income eligible multi-family properties (3+ residential units), as well as Public Housing Authorities can get*:

- **Deeper Incentives** on large projects such as boiler upgrades, HVAC, Variable Speed Drive motor upgrades, and more.
- A **single point of contact** will serve you throughout the entire project to help you select cost-effective solutions, provide ongoing project guidance, and follow-up once work is complete.

NEW!!! Low Income Discount (LID)

Program Details

The Low Income Discount Program is a ComEd program, approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission, that aims to reduce your energy bills through an income-based discount.

LID helps you manage your energy costs. By certifying your income, you may be eligible to **receive a discount on your energy bills, depending on your household income.**

Eligibility

You are eligible for LID if your total household income, or the income of all working individuals combined, is 0% to 300% of the federal poverty level (FPL).

Financial Assistance

Catch Up and Save

Income eligible customers will receive monthly bill credits to help eliminate a past due balance, and be offered a free energy savings kit, which features products that can help lower energy usage and costs now and in the future.

Deposit and Late Payment Waiver

For eligible low-income residential customers only, ComEd will waive deposit and late payment fees for one year. Once enrolled, any current deposit will be applied to an outstanding balance or returned to you. You must reapply each year.

LIHEAP

The Low -Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federal program that provides a **once-a-year grant** to help you with energy bills. Whether you rent or own your home, LIHEAP offers financial assistance to income eligible households.



BILL AND PAYMENT OPTIONS

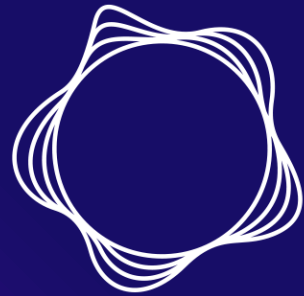
- **Budget Billing:** If electricity use varies widely from month-to-month or from season to season, Budget Billing allows customers to spread the cost of electric bills evenly throughout the year
- **Deferred Payment/Installment Arrangements:** Pay past-due amounts over a set period of time
